- Relators' reactions to Bin pricing
 Jon received correspondence from Susan Hill (Maritime Realty) expressing
 displeasure at not giving to realtors for their clients, Paul reported that all three
 realtors were not happy not being able to pick up "free" bins on behalf of their
 clients. Susan Hill reported she would pay for the 24 they would buy. We will give

- Status of Relator information distribution

Matt will put out a press release. Paul reported Growth Planning would have a table, Tom suggested we invite Heritage Housing, and Jon had invited Climate Initiative.

• Comments for ecomaine re: K'port Contamination — All good so far, Paul suggested we inform the public that we have not had contamination charges so far. Matt offered to do a letter /press release on this.

Matt reported the markets have picked up for recycling in the past seven months, now receiving \$25 per ton for paper (instead of paying \$25), cardboard is up, and plastics are good too. #2 plastics used for plastic lumber; playground equipment; 3-7s used for car bumpers. Paul suggested we do a press release on this, too, because of all the negative press over the past few years, and describe what it's being sold for— what use. Matt will share a Bloomberg article from over the weekend about recycling not being dead.

Goose Rocks Deposit Returns Followup: Mike will check with Laurie on having CLINK drop off at GRBA with the town truck being used to take over.
