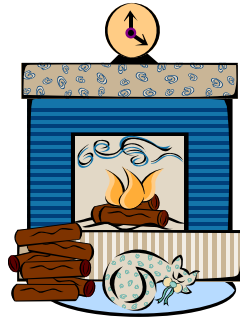


Keep York County Warm Program



If you are concerned about heating costs this winter, you may be eligible for assistance from the Keep York County Warm Program. This program, which began last year, uses volunteers to install weatherization materials and storm window panels in the homes of low-income and disabled homeowners.

How do I sign up?

You must meet the following eligibility criteria with:

- A referral from the York County Community Action.
- A Homeowner Registration and Confidentiality Waiver.
- Availability for two days. First, when volunteers come to perform assessments and measurements, and an additional day for delivery and installation of weatherization materials.
- A signed Homeowner Agreement Form when volunteers visit.

All homeowners need to be registered by Friday, November 11, 2011.
