Minutes of the Selectmen Meeting of September 24, 2015

1. Call to Order.

Chair Matthews-Bull called the meeting to order at 6 PM.

2. Approve the September 8, 10, and 16, 2015, selectmen meeting min utes.

Motion by Selectman Daggett, seconded by Selectman Briggs, to approve the September 8, 2015, selectmen meeting minutes. **Vote**: 3-0-1/Selectman Hutchins abstained because he was not present at that meeting.

Motion by Selectman Hutchins, seconded by Selectman Briggs, to approve the September 10, 2015, selectmen meeting minutes. **Vote**: 3-0-1/Selectman Daggett abstained because he was not present at that meeting.

Motion by Selectman Daggett, seconded by Selectman Briggs, to approve the September 16, 2015, selectmen meeting minutes. **Vote**: 3-0-1/Selectman Hutchins abstained because he was not present at that meeting.

3. Town Manager report.

Police Chief Craig Sanford awarded Officers Nate Jones and Jason Hafner life safety awards. He reported that Mr. Jones assisted with CPR on an individual in distress, and Mr. Hafner rescued a child with a disability on the tidal marsh. He commended them for their life saving actions.

4. Public Forum (This is an opportunity for anyone who wants to address the Board of Selectmen with any issue that is not on the agenda.).

There were no comments.

5. Award the police department cruiser bid.

Chief Sanford said he sent out 11 Requests for Proposals (RFP's) for the purchase of a new 2016 Dodge Charger and received two responses:

- Newcastle Chrysler Dodge \$23,537.00 less \$6,500.00 trade in for the 2012 Dodge Charger. Total purchase price is \$17,037.00
- Bodwell Chrsler-Jeep-Dodge, Inc. \$25,254 less \$4,000 trade in for the 2012 Dodge Charger. Total purchase price is \$21,255

Chief Sanford recommended awarding the bid to Newcastle Chrysler Dodge.

Motion by Selectman Daggett, seconded by Selectman Hutchins, to award the bid for the purchase of a new 2016 Dodge Charger to Newcastle Chrysler Dodge for the total purchase price of \$17,037.00 which includes \$6,500.00 for the trade in. **Vote**: 4-0.

Chair Matthews-Bull explained that these are supplemental bills. She believes that they have already been paid.

Mr. Glasser had been claiming residency in Florida and had received the Homestead Exemption there since 2012. Assessors Agents Donna Moore Hays and Becky R. Nolette submitted supplemental bills which include interest covering 2011 through 2015.

Motion by Selectman Daggett, seconded by Selectman Hutchins, to accept the supplemental bills for William Glasser in the total amount of \$602.46 as recommended by Assessors Agents Donna Moore Hays and Becky R. Nolette. **Vote**: 4-0.

7. Municipal valuation return.

Town Manager Laurie Smith said the Town has to submit this information to the State each year.

She explained that the Municipal Valuation Return verifies to the state the quality of assessed values with sales market data. She said that Kennebunkport is still at 100% market value and saw a net increase of \$10.9 million.

Motion by Selectman Daggett, seconded by Selectman Hutchins, to sign the municipal valuation return. **Vote**: 4-0.

8. Consider Selectmen appointment to the RSU 21 Strategic Planning Committee.

Ms. Smith said the RSU 21 is seeking a Selectman from Arundel, Kennebunk, and Kennebunkport to sit on the RSU 21 Strategic Planning Committee. They meet in September and October on the first Monday of each month, from 5-6 PM at the Kennebunk Elementary School.

Motion by Selectman Hutchins, seconded by Selectman Daggett, to nominate Selectman Barwise to the RSU 21 Strategic Planning Committee. **Vote**: 4-0.

9. Approve a street opening permit for Tim Harrington for property located on Arundel Road (map 15-3-3) for underground services.

Motion by Selectman Daggett, seconded by Selectman Hutchins, to approve a street opening permit for Tim Harrington for property located on Arundel Road (map 15-3-3) for underground services. **Vote: 4-0.**

Chair Matthews-Bull mentioned that the Highway Superintendant signed off on this street opening permit.

10. Accept the donation of a red maple tree for Perkins Park from the family of Daniel Drinon.

Ms. Smith said a family member of Daniel Drinon notified her that the family wished to donate a tree in memory of Daniel Drinon. When Ms. Smith mentioned that they could use a tree at Silas Perkins Park, they donated \$1,313.00 toward the purchase of a red maple tree.

Motion by Selectman Daggett, seconded by Selectman Briggs, to accept a donation in the amount of \$1,313 for the purchase of a red maple tree to be placed at Silas Perkins Park in memory of Daniel Drinon. **Vote**: 4-0.

11. Other business.

a. MMA Voting Delegate

Ms. Smith said the Board needs to approve a voting delegate for the MMA business meeting. She said she is attending and would be happy to be a voting delegate.

Motion by Selectman Daggett, seconded by Selectman Hutchins, to appoint Laurie Smith as an MMA Voting Delegate. **Vote**: 4-0.

Ms. Smith announced that the Town Hall would be closing early on Friday, October 9, at 2 PM, in order to perform building maintenance work.

Ms. Smith also passed out information on the symptoms of the flu and cold. She said flu shots are forthcoming at the Public Health Department.

Chief Sanford presented a brief overview of the changes in the carrying a concealed handgun in Maine law which changes on October 15, 2015.

Selectman Daggett said that Tom Bradbury, executive director of the Kennebunkport Conservation Trust, would like to put signage at Cape Porpoise Pier recognizing the islands. He would like the Board of Selectmen's approval for this signage.

Motion by Selectman Hutchins, seconded by Selectman Briggs, to allow the Kennebunkport Conservation Trust to post signage at Cape Porpoise. **Vote**: 4-0.

The Board had a recess beginning at 6:30 PM.

The meeting resumed at 7 PM.

Chair Matthews-Bull opened the public hearing at 7 PM.

General Assistance Administrator Judith Barrett explained what the MMA Model Ordinance covers. She said individuals on public assistance are not allowed a phone unless they have a slip from the doctor and are not allowed to have cable tv. She said Kennebunkport is fortunate to have community outreach services that provide food and also the emergency fuel program.

Chair Matthews-Bull closed the public hearing at 7:09 PM.

Re: The Houston–Galveston Area Council (HGAC) cooperative purchasing process.

Earlier this spring I had met with Chief John Duross from the Saco Fire Department and he was telling me about how he was purchasing their new fire truck through the HGAC bid process. He said that purchasing the truck though this process saved the city thousands of dollars. The HGAC has gone out to bid with several different truck manufactures and has gotten bids for purchasing trucks and equipment. The manufacturers have submitted base prices for their truck chassis and you can build the truck from there. The manufacturers supply you with a list of all the options with the prices for that truck chasse and you can put together your own specifications for the truck.

I met with Laurie about using this process for purchasing the new fire truck; she was not familiar with this purchasing process so I sent the information on this process to Drummond & Woodsum so they could check it out and to give us their opinion. When they checked in to it, they can see no reason for us not to purchase the truck in this way. I have also checked around and there are several towns and cities in Maine that have purchased trucks through this process. The City of Saco and the town of Monmouth are both purchasing trucks through this process this year.

I would like to proceed with the purchase of the new truck in this manner, I believe it will save us money and will speed up the process of purchasing a fire truck.

THIS INTERLOCAL CONTRACT ("Contract"), made and entered into pursuant to the Texas Interlocal Cooperation Act, Chapter 791, Texas Government Code (the "Act"), by and between the Houston-Galveston Area Council, hereinafter referred to as "H-GAC," having its principal place of business at 3555 Timmons Lane, Suite 120, Houston, Texas 77027, and *Kennebunkport Fire Department, a local government, a state agency, or a non-profit corporation created and operated to provide one or more governmental functions and services, hereinafter referred to as "End User," having its principal place of business at *32 North Street. Kennebunkport Maine 04046
WITNESSETH
WHEREAS, H-GAC is a regional planning commission and political subdivision of the State of Texas operating under Chapter 391 Texas Local Government Code; and
WHEREAS, pursuant to the Act, H-GAC is authorized to contract with eligible entities to perform governmental functions and services, including the purchase of goods and services; and
WHEREAS, in reliance on such authority, H-GAC has instituted a cooperative purchasing program under which it contracts with eligible entities under the Act; and
WHEREAS, End User has represented that it is an eligible entity under the Act, that its governing body has authorized this Contract or *(Date), and that it desires to contract with H-GAC on the terms set forth below;
NOW, THEREFORE, H-GAC and the End User do hereby agree as follows:
ARTICLE 1: LEGAL AUTHORITY The End User represents and warrants to H-GAC that (1) it is eligible to contract with H-GAC under the Act because it is one of the following: a local government, as defined in the Act (a county, a municipality, a special district, or other political subdivision of the State of Texas or any other state), or a combination of two or more of those entities, a state agency (an agency of the State of Texas as defined in Section 771.002 of the Texas Government Code, or a similar agency of another state), or a non-profit corporation created and operated to provide one or more governmental functions and services, and (2) it possesses adequate legal authority to enter into this Contract.
ARTICLE 2: APPLICABLE LAWS H-GAC and the End User agree to conduct all activities under this Contract in accordance with all applicable rules, regulations, and ordinances and laws in effect or promulgated during the term of this Contract.
ARTICLE 3: WHOLE AGREEMENT This Contract and any attachments, as provided herein, constitute the complete contract between the parties hereto, and supersede any and all oral and written agreements between the parties relating to matters herein.
ARTICLE 4: PERFORMANCE PERIOD

The period of this Contract shall be for the balance of the fiscal year of the End User, which began *______ and ends *______. This Contract shall thereafter automatically be renewed annually for each succeeding fiscal year, provided that such renewal shall not have the effect of extending the period in which the End User may make any payment due an H-GAC contractor beyond the fiscal year in which such obligation was incurred under this Contract.

ARTICLE 5: SCOPE OF SERVICES

The End User appoints H-GAC its true and lawful purchasing agent for the purchase of certain products and services through the H-GAC Cooperative Purchasing Program. End User will access the Program through <u>HGACBuy.com</u> and by submission of any duly executed purchase order, in the form prescribed by H-GAC to a contractor having a valid contract with H-GAC. All purchases hereunder shall be in accordance with specifications and contract terms and pricing established by H-GAC. Ownership (title) to products purchased through H-GAC shall transfer directly from the contractor to the End User.

ARTICLE 6: PAYMENTS

H-GAC will confirm each order and issue notice to contractor to proceed. Upon delivery of goods or services purchased, and presentation of a properly documented invoice, the End User shall promptly, and in any case within thirty (30) days, pay H-GAC's contractor the full amount of the invoice. All payments for goods or services will be made from current revenues available to the paying party. In no event shall H-GAC have any financial liability to the End User for any goods or services End User procures from an H-GAC contractor.

ARTICLE 7: CHANGES AND AMENDMENTS

This Contract may be amended only by a written amendment executed by both parties, except that any alterations, additions, or deletions to the terms of this Contract which are required by changes in Federal and State law or regulations are automatically incorporated into this Contract without written amendment hereto and shall become effective on the date designated by such law or regulation.

H-GAC reserves the right to make changes in the scope of products and services offered through the H-GAC Cooperative Purchasing Program to be performed hereunder.

ARTICLE 8: TERMINATION PROCEDURES

H-GAC or the End User may cancel this Contract at any time upon thirty (30) days written notice by certified mail to the other party to this Contract. The obligations of the End User, including its obligation to pay H-GAC's contractor for all costs incurred under this Contract prior to such notice shall survive such cancellation, as well as any other obligation incurred under this Contract, until performed or discharged by the End User.

ARTICLE 9: SEVERABILITY

All parties agree that should any provision of this Contract be determined to be invalid or unenforceable, such determination shall not affect any other term of this Contract, which shall continue in full force and effect.

ARTICLE 10: FORCE MAJEURE

To the extent that either party to this Contract shall be wholly or partially prevented from the performance within the term specified of any obligation or duty placed on such party by reason of or through strikes, stoppage of labor, riot, fire, flood, acts of war, insurrection, accident, order of any court, act of God, or specific cause reasonably beyond the party's control and not attributable to its neglect or nonfeasance, in such event, the time for the performance of such obligation or duty shall be suspended until such disability to perform is removed; provided, however, force majeure shall not excuse an obligation solely to pay funds. Determination of force majeure shall rest solely with H-GAC.

ARTICLE 11: VENUE

Disputes between procuring party and Vendor are to be resolved in accord with the law and venue rules of the State of purchase.

Re: To purchase the air release valves for the force mains coming from the pump station.

One of the projects that we planned on do this year was to replace the air release vales that are on the force mains coming from the pump stations. The air release valves allow any air or gas that may become trapped in high points of the pipe to escape. When air accumulates in the pipe reduces the flow of water thought the pipe and causes higher pump pressures, a decrease in flows rates which increases pumping costs.

We have contacted the following venders for pricing to replace the valves:

<u>GL. Lyons Associates</u> who sell ARI valves, they recommended that we purchase a stainless steel higher pressure valve for the force main from pump station #12 and lower pressure composite valves for all the other valve locations.

Stainless Steel valve \$1,435.00 Composite valves \$1,018.00

They are also offering up to a 25% discount in the price if we supply them with the electricity usage for the time before we install the valves, and the electricity usage after we install the new valves.

Allagash International Inc. who sell Val-Matic valves.

Stainless Steel valve with flush kit \$1,559.13

Atlantic Fluid Technology Inc. who sell DeZurik valves.

Stainless Steel valve \$2,986.00

I would like to recommend that we purchase the valves from GL Lyons Associates.

Town of Kennebunkport, Maine Policy Regarding Check Disbursement Prior To Expenditure Warrant Approval

Purpose. This policy allows designated municipal officers (selectmen), acting on behalf of the full board of municipal officers, to review, approve, and sign municipal treasurer's disbursement warrants, for wages and benefits, state fees, and school district costs only.

This policy is additional to, not in lieu of, majority power. Nothing in this policy is intended to replace the authority of the full board of municipal officers, acting by majority vote, to act on any treasurer's warrant, including warrants for wages and benefits. Delegation of authority. Pursuant to 30-A MRSA § 5603(2)(A)(1), the following authority is granted with respect to treasurer's disbursement warrants for municipal employee wages and benefits only:

Current municipal officers. The municipal officers in office at the time of execution of this policy are:

Allen Daggett, Sheila Mathews-Bull, Stuart Barwise, Edward Hutchins, and Patrick Briggs.

Any one of the municipal officers named above, acting alone, may review, approve, and sign such warrants.

Deadline for bill submission

To be considered for payment on the next expenditure warrant, bills for payment must be received by the Treasurer of Kennebunkport at least two working days prior to the scheduled meeting of the Board of Selectmen at which an expenditure warrant signing is scheduled. The treasurer, may, at his discretion, present vouchers for payment after the deadline when time permits, or doing so is in the best interest of the town.

Effective date. This policy becomes effective on the date indicated below.

Lapse. This policy tapses one year after its effective date, if not sooner amended or cancelled.

Renewal. This policy may be renewed at any time before its lapse. Thereafter, it may be readopted at any time. Any renewal is valid for one year from its effective date, unless a sooner date of expiration is specified.

If the municipal treasurer is an appointed official, the treasurer shall remind the municipal officers to consider renewing this policy annually before it lapses.
