





Selectmen Daggett would like to see steps to get up to the rock at the pier.





 - Capital Improvement amounts are usually carried forward to the next fiscal year.





Unassigned Fund Balance as a % of Budget - Comparative






GENERAL FUND – Expenditure Distribution - 2017
