Request to Relocate Parking

Dear Larry,

In response to the discussions with the Board of Selectmen on January 8, 2013 we have reviewed the existing site conditions and options for addressing the concerns with the relocation of the two on-street parking spaces associated with the elimination of one curb cut and relocation of the driveway to serve 239 and 241 Kings Highway. The following documentation and enclosed plan have been prepared for discussion with the Goose Rocks Beach Advisory Committee and with the Board of Selectmen.

- The dimension of the existing four spaces to the west of the driveway serving 239 Kings HWY is 83 FT by 8 FT. There is a 5 FT safe zone at either end of the parking and the existing driveways for 237 and 239 Kings HWY.
- The town requirement for the length of a parking space is 20 FT. The relocation of the new driveway reduces the length of the area for parking to 52 FT, not including the 5 FT safe zone to the new driveway. There is insufficient space to provide three 20 foot spaces as discussed with the Selectmen.
- Regarding the length of the parking space to the east of the crosswalk, we confirmed that the space is 30 FT long. Reducing the length of the space to 20 FT would improve sight distance conditions of the crosswalk for vehicles traveling west. The space between the parking and the crosswalk would be increased from 9 FT +/- to 19 FT +/-.
