The incident commander or designate shall have your name tag from the truck/boat patch or directly from the individual. The incident commander or designate shall give back the truck/boat patch or your individual tag when cleared to leave the scene.

COLOR CODING

Green interior qualified in Kennebunkport Red fire ground qualified Blue – KEMS

All structure, alarm activations fire calls and 10:55's

Each vehicle has a patch located on the engine cowl or in Goose Rocks 33 on the pump panel

Each person riding on the truck shall attach their individual name tag to the patch on the truck. Driver shall be on the top.

On arrival at the incident, the patch with the individual name tag attach, shall be given to the incident commander or resource officer. When alone, the driver shall be responsible to get the truck patch to the incident commander or resource officer. When there is an additional person on the truck the driver shall designate a person to hand deliver the truck patch to the incident commander or resource officer. At the end of the incident it shall be incident commander's responsibility to return the truck patch to the driver of the appropriate apparatus.

Individuals arriving in personnel vehicles shall hand their tags directly to the incident commander or designated individual. Upon leaving the incident scene the individual shall pick up their tag.

Structure or confined entry

The individual firefighter shall hand their name tag to the designated person at the entry point when entering a building or restricted area.

On exiting the individual firefighter shall retrieve their tag

Boat calls

Each Boat has a patch located on the engine cowl.

Each person in the boat shall attach their individual name tag to the patch on the boat.

On arrival at the incident, the patch with the individual name tag attach, shall be given to the shore incident commander.

At the end of the incident it shall be incident commander's responsibility to return the boat patch to the highest ranking officer responsible for the boat.

Individuals arriving in personnel vehicles shall hand their tags directly to the shore incident commander or designated individual. Upon leaving the incident scene the individual shall pick up their tag.

Missing person, forest and brush fires

Each vehicle has a patch located on the truck

Each person riding on the truck shall attach their individual name tag to the patch on the truck. The driver tag shall be on the top.

On arrival at the incident, the patch with the individual name tag attach, shall be given to the incident commander. When alone, the driver shall be responsible to get the truck patch to the incident commander. When there is an additional person on the truck the driver shall designate a person to hand deliver the truck patch to the incident commander. At the end of the incident it shall be incident commander's responsibility to return the truck patch to the driver of the appropriate apparatus.

Individuals arriving in personnel vehicles shall hand their tags directly to the incident commander or designated individual. Upon leaving the incident scene the individual shall pick up their tag from their designated fire unit.
