Minutes/Actions from the previous meeting on 11 July 2019 were accepted.

There was discussion regarding the offered brick paving of a section along Ocean Ave in front of the River Club. Our committee feels that the bricks will buckle and cause a walking hazard, We feel that the Town should not take on the increased liability of pedestrian injury and also the higher maintenance involved with this type of pavement. Our views have been presented to the Selectmen at their last meeting by Susan Boak and Bill Llefler.

The committee discussed again our goals for proposed housing in the Village Parcel. As presented to that committee we feel strongly that any housing should be multi-generational and should reflect the architectural character of the town.

The possibility of assisted living in Kennebunkport has been raised as a separate issue from Village Parcel development. We continue to look at options and outside examples. This issue would need a lot of work to flesh out involving a survey and focus groups. We feel it would require too much work for the Committee at this time. We need to know how much of our base is interested,
