Day Camp Director: We need a motivated, responsible supervisor for our summer day camp. This 10-week administrative position will plan and implement a wide variety of activities and special events, manage staff and CITs, coordinate training, maintain records and emergency information on all participants, and handle public relations for the program. **Education in recreation or similar youth-oriented field plus experience in progressively responsible summer day camp or recreation programming is expected.**
