Goose Rocks & Colony Beach Water Status May 31, 2013

The laboratory results are in for May 30th retests at Goose Rocks Beach. The Advisory has been lifted.

All of Goose Rocks Beach and Colony Beach test site results are within acceptable levels. Both beaches and the mouths of the Little, Batson and Smith Rivers are open for water contact.

The town of Kennebunkport participates in the healthy Maine Beaches Program, which is a cooperative partnership to test the water quality of Maine beaches. Volunteers take tests once each week. If tests identify elevated bacteria levels, the public is notified to avoid water contact.
