

Beach Advisory June 5, 2007

GOOSE ROCKS BEACH WATER STATUS

June 6, 2007

The laboratory tests results are in for samples taken on June 5, 2007. All sites at Goose Rocks Beach as well as at Colony Beach are elevated. It is advised that you avoid water contact at these sites at this time. This advisory is in affect until further notice. The next sampling will be conducted on June 12, 2007. Tests results should be in by late afternoon on June 13.

The Town of Kennebunkport participates in the Maine Healthy Beaches program which is a cooperative partnership to test the water quality of Maine beaches. Volunteers take tests once each week. If tests identify elevated bacteria levels, the public is notified to avoid water contact.
