Goose Rocks & Colony Beach Water Status

June 18, 2014

The laboratory results are in for June 17, 2014.

Even though both Colony and the mouth of the Little River site results are slightly elevated, I am not posting an Advisory at this time. I feel that this slight elevation is the final effect for 6/13 rainfall.

The town of Kennebunkport participates in the Healthy Maine Beaches Program, which is a cooperative partnership to test the water quality of Maine beaches. Volunteers take tests once each week. If tests identify elevated bacteria levels of over 104, the public is notified to avoid water contact. A repeat test is then conducted as soon as possible.
