July 10, 2013

The laboratory tests results are in for samples taken on July 9, 2013. The Advisory for Colony Beach has been lifted. An Advisory is in place for Goose Rocks Beach. There are elevated bacteria levels at the mouth of the Little & Batson Rivers. It is advised that you avoid water contact at these sites. This advisory is in place until further notice.

Next water sample testing will be July 11, 2013

The Town of Kennebunkport participates in the Maine Healthy Beaches Program which is a cooperative partnership to test the water quality of Maine beaches. Volunteers take tests once each week. If tests identify elevated bacteria levels, the public is notified to avoid water contact.

NOTE: An Advisory is posted with any sample result exceeding the EPA set limit of 104.
