

Beach Advisory-July 11, 2006

Goose Rocks and Colony Beach Water Status

The laboratory results are in for July 11, 2006

Elevated bacteria levels are at:

Site number 3 at the end of Belair Avenue

Site number 5 at the southwest end of the beach; mouths of Batsons and Smith Rivers and end of Kings Highway

Advisories are posted on the basis of these elevations. The public is advised to avoid water contact at elevated sites.

All other sites are within acceptable range.

The town of Kennebunkport participates in the Healthy Maine Beaches Program, which is a cooperative partnership to test the water quality of Maine beaches.

Volunteers take tests once each week. If tests identify elevated bacteria levels, the public is notified to avoid water contact. Kennebunkport's water quality dedicated line: 967- 0407

The next water testing will be conducted on July 13, 2006.
