GOOSE ROCKS BEACH WATER STATUS

July13,2007

The laboratory tests results are in for samples taken on July12, 2007. The sample taken at site 4—the public access 177 Kings Highway continues to be elevated. It is advised that you avoid water contact at this site at this time. This advisory is in affect until further notice. The next sampling will be conducted on July 17, 2007. Tests results should be in by late in the afternoon on July 18th. The Town of Kennebunkport participates in the Maine Healthy Beaches program which is a cooperative partnership to test the water quality of Maine beaches. Volunteers take tests once each week. If tests identify elevated bacteria levels, the public is notified to avoid water contact.
