GOOSE ROCKS BEACH WATER STATUS

August 3, 2007

The laboratory tests results are in for samples taken on August 2, 2007. The samples taken at the mouth of the Little River and the mouth of the Batson/ Smith Rivers are elevated. It is advised that you avoid water contact at these sites at this time. This advisory is in place until further notice.

The next sampling will be conducted on August 7, 2007. Tests results should be in by late in the afternoon on August 8th. The Town of Kennebunkport participates in the Maine Healthy Beaches program which is a cooperative partnership to test the water quality of Maine beaches. Volunteers take tests once each week. If tests identify elevated bacteria levels, the public is notified to avoid water contact.
