

Beach Advisory August 8, 2007

GOOSE ROCKS BEACH WATER STATUS

August 8, 2007

The laboratory tests results are in for samples taken on August 7, 2007. The sample taken at Colony Beach is elevated. It is advised that you avoid water contact at this site at this time. This advisory is in place until further notice. All Goose Rocks Beach sites were within acceptable limits.

The next sampling at Colony Beach will be conducted on August 9, 2007. Tests results should be in by late in the afternoon on August 10th

The Town of Kennebunkport participates in the Maine Healthy Beaches program which is a cooperative partnership to test the water quality of Maine beaches. Volunteers take tests once each week. If tests identify elevated bacteria levels, the public is notified to avoid water contact.
