

Beach Advisory - August 20, 2005

Goose Rocks Beach Water Status

The laboratory test results are in for August 19. The water samples taken at the mouth of the Little River, Belair Ave and at 177 Kings Highway were elevated. It is advised that you avoid any water contact at these sites at this time. This advisory is in effect until further notice. The bacteria levels at the remainder of the beach and Colony Beach are within acceptable limits.

The Town of Kennebunkport participates in the Healthy Maine Beaches program which is a cooperative partnership to test the water quality of Maine beaches. Volunteers take water tests once each week. If tests identify elevated bacteria levels, the public is notified to avoid water contact. At this time the Town of Kennebunkport is increasing the testing frequency to daily to assist in the determination of bacteria sources.
