Mutual Aid to Arundel Structure Fire

To provide automatic coverage to the below area: Log Cabin Road to railroad tracks, Piersons farm to Sinnott Road including Burnham Road, Lombard Road, and Goose Rocks Road; Sinnott Road to railroad bridge, and North Street to Durrells Bridge via Arundel and River Road will be Engine 13, 23, and Ladder 34. If Engine 23 doesn't clear then Engine 12 will respond if Ladder 34 doesn't clear then Ladder 4 responds.

Mutual Aid to Arundel other than above will be as requested with the exception of station coverage which will be Engine 13. If a ladder is requested, it will be Ladder 34.

Mutual Aid to Kennebunk per agreement will be Engine 13 and Ladder 34.

Mutual Aid to Biddeford Pool for station coverage will be Ladder 34.

Mutual Aid other than above will be as requested by the requesting fire department.

Stations not providing apparatus are requested to be manned to provide a quicker response if needed.

All out Town mutual aid calls will be Box 33.

Special conditions for members belonging to a Kennebunk and Kennebunkport Fire Company jointly.

1. A master training record will be maintained by the Fire Department that is located in the individuals town of voting registration.
2. The individual must agree to sharing of information in the master file with the other fire department.
3. Both fire departments will notify each other of training that the individual has participated in by the 31st of December of each year.
4. Members belonging to the Kennebunk and Kenebunkport Fire Departments jointly will be covered for injuries and pay compensation by the municipality in which the work was done or the injury occurred (Kennebunk or Kennebunkport) *The intent is to limit who was liable but to insure*

the individual was provided with medical payments. It is specific to joint membership only.

5. Injuries and compensation occurring to a person belonging to both the Kennebunk and Kennebunkport Fire Departments in a third municipality to which both Kennebunk and Kennebunkport are called upon to provide mutual aid will be paid by the town which responded 1st to the request for mutual aid. In the event of an injury the individual must report it to both Kennebunk and Kennebunkport so that appropriate paper work can be filed. The decision on which town will pay the medical expense, if in question, will be made *jointly* by the Kennebunk Fire Chief and Kennebunkport Fire Chief or their duly appointed representatives.
