Welcome

Leave No Trace Be sure to remove your gear and debris when you leave the beach. Please fill in holes dug in the sand.

Protect and Respect Birds & Wildlife
Please stay away from piping plover nesting areas and dune grass. Collect

seashells but please leave living sea creatures and plants as you found them.

Strong Currents Be aware of the strong tidal rivers at both ends of the beach. Watch the clock and don't get caught by the tide. Accompany non-swimmers to the islands. No lifeguard is on duty.

Respect 25-Foot Reserved Areas
Some owners may ask you to sit or play beyond their 25 foot dry sand

"Reserved Area." Please cooperate. Check the brochure for rules of use and locations.

Be Considerate Avoid loud music or noise - let nature's sounds be heard, especially at night. Play sports under control and away from seating areas.

Control Your Dogs Dogs must be leashed. Remove your dog's waste from the beach. Please quiet barking dogs.

Dogs permitted ONLY: June 15 to September 15—before 8 am and after 6 pm September 15- May 15—no time restrictions

Beach Rules Prohibit:

- Storage of boats or beach equipment on beach overnight without property owner's permission
