- ⊗ Alcohol consumption
- ⊗ Camping or sleeping overnight
- ⊗ Collecting live creatures
- ⊗ Climbing on seawalls
- ⊗ Fireworks
- ⊗ Glass containers
- ⊗ Launching motorized boats
- ⊗ Motorized vehicles
- ⊗ Open fires and fire pits
- ⊗ Smoking and vaping
- ⊗ Speeding watercraft near shoreline
- ⊗ Storage of boats or beach gear overnight
- ⊗ Storage of boats or beach gear on dune grass
- ⊗ Walking on dunes or dune grass
- ⊗ Leaving holes on beach

The Plovers Are Nesting!



Goose Rocks Beach is one of Maine's essential habitats for endangered Plovers and Terns. Historically, the birds have nested at the west end from April through August. However, Plovers have been known to nest elsewhere on the beach.

- 🐦 Please be **alert to signs & wire cages** that mark nesting areas.
- 🐦 Dogs must be **leashed** and kept at least 200' away from marked nesting areas.
- 🐦 There are **finest** for non-compliance of the Dog Leash Ordinance as well as serious federal fines possible under the Endangered Species Act.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

PARKING only permitted in posted spaces on King's Highway, Dyke Road, & New Biddeford Road.

Parking PERMITS are required from Memorial Day Weekend – Labor Day between 8 AM and 6 PM.

PARKING FEES - Nonresident: \$25 daily, \$100 weekly, and \$200 seasonal. Passes can be purchased at kiosks at the GRB General Store and near Proctor Avenue entrance.

PUBLIC BEACH ACCESS only at posted entrances.

RESPECT 25 - FOOT RESERVED AREAS – Beach Use Agreement signers may ask you to sit or play beyond their 25-foot sand "Reserved Areas." Please cooperate.
