Minutes/Actions from the previous meeting on 1 August 2018 were accepted.

- 4. SA\_AI\_11, with regards to increased pedestrian visibility at night, especially during Prelude. George Acker found some low cost LED flashlights from USFLASHLIGHTS.com. Bill Leffler will pursue funding options.

Motions: Amy Francis nominated Susan Boak as the new chair. This was seconded and unanimously approved. Amy will take over management of the action items and minutes.
