# Site and Floor Plan Design Notes

- Site Design
  - O Square footages for the estimate were scaled directly off of the current site plans and are not final
  - Moved new wing to the east to reduce cutting into the hill
  - O Reduced the length of the service road to the west to reduce cutting into the hill
  - O Service yard at rear (south) 5,000 gal oil tank, transformer, turnaround for delivery vehicles
  - O Short access drive to kitchen on north side for deliveries. Screened dumpster there or at rear requiring food to be dollied to the dumpster. Could reinstate service drive from the south
  - O Alyce Swan found archived test pits to help determine depth to ledge soils on the hill are mapped as "Lyman" which may mean shallow depth to ledge. Architects will review.
  - Maximizing reuse of existing paving bus loop, east parking lot

- Expanded parking existing count +/- 64 cars, current proposal 144 cars including double loaded parking in front and approx. 48 spaces shown on Town land if feasible.
- O KBPT ordinances may require 100+ cars. Verify with Town Planner.
- Getting proposal for site survey adding to the impervious area on a very flat site, stormwater drainage, retention basins
- O Gathering utility data sewer, storm, water domestic and sprinkler system, electrical
- O Playground moved to front of school next to bus drop-off, raise bed for better drainage, verify size of bed
- O Potential to move generator to new boiler room area
- O Sledding hill maintained
- Keep excess excavation material on site if possible

### Floor Plan Design

- O Square footages for the estimate were scaled directly off of the current floor plans and are not final
- Demolition of the entire gym/café/kitchen wing
- O Provide a new, full kitchen, not a warming kitchen
- Moved boiler room to rear (south)
- O Shifted gym wing east to reduce cut into the hill
- O Potential to move generator to new boiler room
- O See Facilities Inventory for details on major categories of work:
  - Building envelope
  - Mechanical and electrical systems replacement
  - Add sprinkler system
  - Paving, parking, drainage improvements
  - ADA (accessibility), NPFA (fire), and UBC (building) code upgrades
  - Improvements in energy efficiency mechanical controls, lighting controls, insulation, exterior wall construction
  - Improved building security
  - Improved educational technology systems
  - Remove the modulars
  - New educational space
