Minutes/Actions from the previous meeting on 12 September 2018 were accepted.

Mary-Lou Boucouvalas, Graves Librarian, presented a revised schedule for Senior Education Seminars. Due to a scheduling conflict with the Kennebunkport Chief of Police, the seminar on telephone scams, shelter preparedness and CodeRED has been moved to Thursday, December 13 at 9:30 am.

Instead, Molly Hoadley from No Place Like Home in Kennebunk will speak to the topic of Community Services in the Kennebunks on October 25 at 9:30 am.

Susan Boak wondered why this group had been moved from March to October and expressed concern that the committee was currently working on a thread related to the 27% of senior survey respondents who reported varying degrees of difficulty driving at night. We had hoped to have an eye doctor speak on this topic early this fall. Mary-Lou took an action to contact Dr. Graichen's office to determine if a date, not part of the Senior Seminars, might be possible.

Action items emerging from our meeting with Mary-Lou are:

SAC_AI_17: Mary-Lou to contact Dr. Graichen's office to determine if a date may be arranged with one of their ophthalmologists to speak at Graves Library on the topic of nighttime driving difficulties.

The discussion next moved to preparing for a table at the Town Election on November 6, as was discussed with Laurie Smith at our initial meeting. The Town Clerk has indicated we should be prepared to bring a table and to clean up afterwards. The table needs to be manned from 8 am to 8 pm. Bill Leffler indicated he would like his shift to overlap with his wife's as she is working at the election. Susan will make a poster from a flyer furnished by the Maine Bicycle and Safety Education Program. She also demonstrated an LED snap bracelet.

Our next meetings have been scheduled for October 10th and also October 24th to work on the town election. The meeting adjourned at 9:42am.
