Goose Rocks Beach Recycling Pick Up

Goose Rocks Beach Summer Trash & Recycling Schedule

Trash and recycling collection occurs on Fridays in the Goose Rocks Beach area in the spring, fall and winter.

In the summer, the collection schedule changes to Saturdays.

Summer of 2018 Collection Days

Saturday, June 16, 2018
through
Saturday, September 15, 2018

Recycling will be every Saturday during this time.

The schedule returns to Fridays for trash and recycling pickup starting September 21, 2018. The recycling schedule is back to every other week starting on this day.

Hours of collection start at 6:30 a.m.



The Town of Kennebunkport provides curbside recycling collection on a bi-weekly basis. The recycling collection starts at 6:30 a.m. All recycling should be out at curbside no earlier than 6:00 p.m. the day before your collection and no later than 6:30 a.m. on your collection day. Recycling should be in a blue recycling bin. Recycling bins are available at the Town Office, during normal business hours.

What Can Be Recycled

*All Types of Recyclable Materials Go Into The Same Box...
No Need To Separate!*

Recycling Paper:

What Can Be Recycled: We can recycle most paper. Specifically, office paper, mail, newspapers, magazines, phone books, catalogs, all books, & paper bags.

What to Exclude: NO carbon paper, NO photographs, NO paper contaminated with food, NO waxed paper, and NO facial tissue paper or paper towels.

Recycling Paperboard and Cardboard:

What Can Be Recycled: Acceptable materials include clean/empty boxes with any metal and plastic removed: cereal, rice, cake mix, salt, medicine, toiletry, aspirin, band-aid, & shirt boxes. Also included are: tubes from toilet paper & paper towel rolls, writing pad backs, poster board, paperboard egg cartons and clean corrugated cardboard boxes, gable top milk & juice cartons, & aseptic containers.

What to Exclude: NO waxed paper or waxed cardboard boxes such as those used to ship vegetables and meats, NO foil liners, NO plastic liners.

Recycling Plastic:

What Can Be Recycled: Specifically milk jugs, cider jugs, water jugs and similar #2 plastic containers. Detergent bottles, bleach bottles, and similar #2 colored plastic containers. Vegetable oil, soda, and similar #1 clear or colored plastic. All #1-7 plastic containers are now acceptable. This includes, #1 or #2 butter tubs, yogurt containers, microwave dishes, and peanut butter containers. All #3-7 containers. This includes #3-7 tubs, lids and containers. Plastic shopping sacks marked with a recycling symbol can be recycled.

What to Exclude: NO containers with product in them, all containers must be empty. NO plastic without the recycling triangle and a plastic identification number of #1-7. NO Styrofoam (not even #6). NO CD/DVD jewel cases, NO Ziploc-type bags, NO cling wrap or shrink wrap. NO trash bags or dry cleaning bags.

Recycling Glass:

What Can Be Recycled: Clear and colored glass bottles and jars.

What to Exclude: NO window glass. NO auto glass, such as windshields, NO safety glass with a plastic or metal inner membrane, NO ceramic or mirror glass.

Recycling Cans and Aluminum:

What Can Be Recycled: Metal food and beverage cans, aluminum foil, aluminum trays and pans, pots & pans, and empty aerosol cans.

What to Exclude: NO propane tanks or bottles. NO small or large appliances.
