Townwide Mapping (30 min.)

INSTRUCTIONS:

Say hello... Take a moment to allow everyone at your table to introduce themselves, share their affiliation (resident, business owner, staff, etc).

TALK WITH YOUR MARKERS and draw ideas on the map. If ideas can't be drawn, make written notations **in marker**. Topics to discuss:

Development:

- Where should new development happen on the Village Parcel?
- Where would you like to see additional businesses activity?
- Where would you like to see housing?
- Where would you like to see any other buildings and uses? Please notate the uses on the map.

Open Space:

- Where should land be conserved with limited human access?
- Where should trails and walking paths be located?
- Where should other recreational opportunities occur, such as parks, ball fields, ice skating rinks, or other activities go? Please notate the uses on the map.

Mobility:

- Where could the village parcel help make important linkages for walking and biking?
- Where could additional street connections be made, to help distribute vehicular traffic and reduce traffic pressure along Maine Street?

Municipal Services:

- Should water and sewer systems be expanded onto the Village Parcel? If so, where?
- Should the Village Parcel accommodate any municipal buildings or uses? If so, which ones and where?
